Demolition of clubhouse pool to commence in early May



With permits in hand, Bremik Construction will begin demolition of the clubhouse pool area, boiler room, and filter room as early as May 11. The clubhouse will remain open for business ... and pleasure ... and measures are being taken to minimize any disruptions in operations. We won't be bringing in a wrecking ball but there will be dust flying! Parking in the upper and lower lots won't be affected but landscaping surrounding the building will need to be modified during the renovation process. The massage room on the lower level will become the construction office for the duration of the renovation.
