Engineer Cook is the captain of Mountain Park's aquatic center resurrection, one of the center-pieces of our ongoing clubhouse renovation.



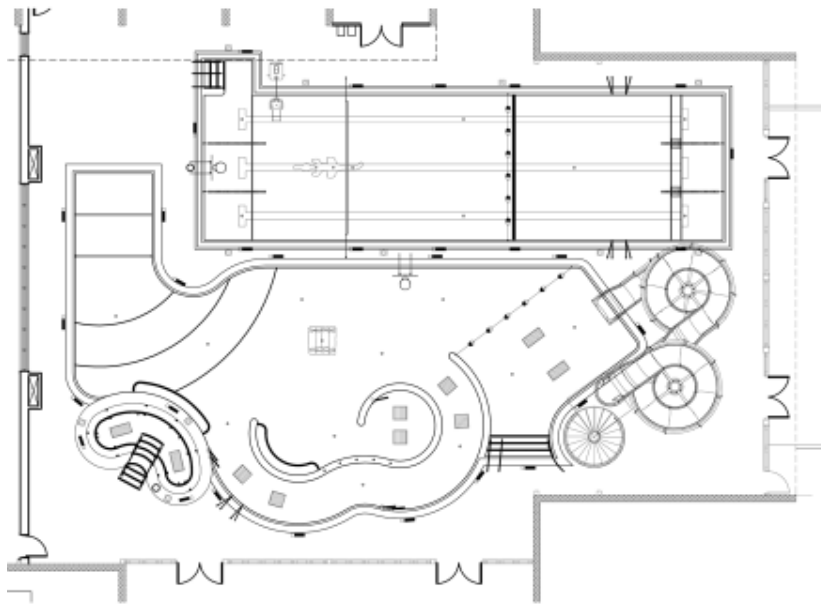
A partner and studio director at Councilman-Hunsaker and registered professional engineer in 31 states, Doug likes this project.

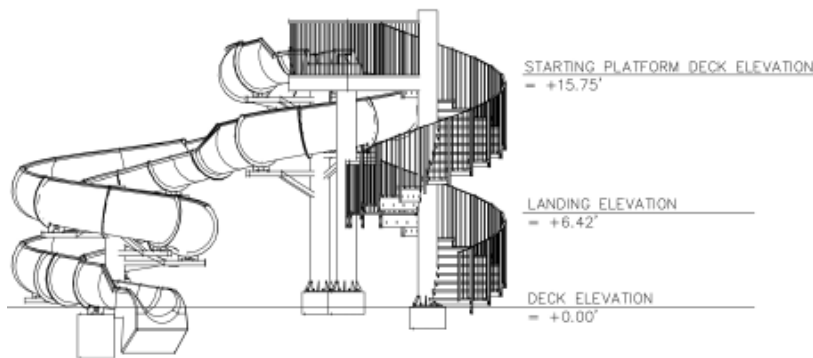
When he isn't swimming, Doug enjoys snow sports, hiking and biking with his wife and three kids.

Final pool design makes a splash!

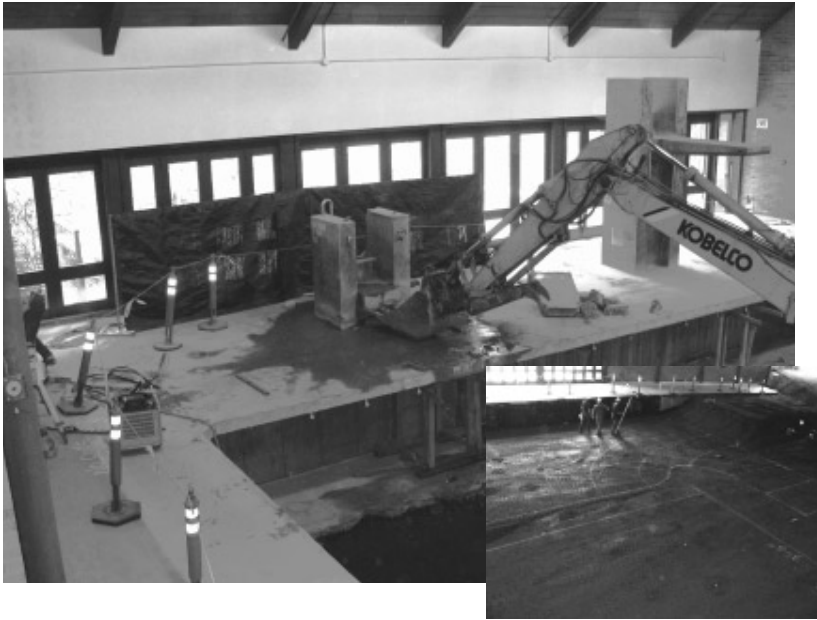


The final pool design has something for everyone. It will feature shallow and deep water, beach entry, vortex, current channel, kidney-shaped therapeutic spa, showers on deck, and a custom built slide.



Due to the renovation, the locker rooms will be closed. Residents are asked to detour through the basketball court to reach the weight and cardio rooms.

The lines are drawn ... for the new pool!



A large track hoe attempts to lift the base of the old diving board. Insert: With the pool shell completely removed and filled in, lines are painted where the new pools will go.

And, in other parts of the clubhouse ...



Levers are removed from the lower level adjacent to the boiler room.

A 2,500 lb fan is lifted out from the lower level.



The boilers dismantled piece by piece.

TIMELINE

- July - contracts awarded to the sub contractors
- July - Ordering of long lead time equipment (slide, elevator, lighting)
- July - Elevator hoist way construction
- July - Ceiling work in natatorium to include paint and electrical
